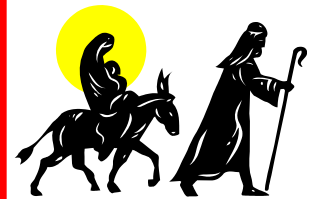

Memory Verse: Acts 5:41-42 The apostles left the Sanhedrin, rejoicing because they had been counted worthy of suffering disgrace for the Name. Day after day, in the temple courts and from house to house, they never stopped teaching and proclaiming the good news that Jesus is the Christ.

Discussion Questions: Have you ever faced persecution for your faith? How did you respond? How do you react to news and stories of people who suffer or risk their lives because of faith in Jesus? What does it mean to you to be all-in on the promises of God?
